There is an excess of 32K which could be used to fund the AGIIS update with the AWSA numbers if board agrees. If not spent on the AWSA project then the funds are to be returned to the participants.	
	4. AGIIS Directory	Hunter	Decide on the additional needs for AGIIS directory. Review estimate to add the CPC and AWSA numbers.	Board will need to determine if there is a motion for the project change request(PCR) to add the AWSA number.  The cost is 182 hours @ \$80/hr = 14,560. This is the cost if the motion moves in 2014. If it is implemented in 2015 the cost may increase by approx. 10%.
