

What is AgGateway?



AgGateway is an agriculture-industry-funded non-profit consortium leading the global transition to digital agriculture.





What do we mean by Digital Agriculture...

Working Definition: Digital Agriculture is the production of food, fiber, and biofuels, and environmental management through processes that are increasingly autonomous and driven by ever more effective models with data input that is more and more timely, relevant, accurate, and complete. The models are designed to maximize profitability, sustainability, and environmental protection in optimal balance.



Why digital agriculture

Success in agriculture today requires:

- Mastering the use and exchange of data
- Maximizing efficiency and productivity
- Tightening financial management of large-scale costs



2020 Plan Objectives

- Complete AgGateway 2020 transition by 31 December 2020.
- Benchmark use of current digital resources, develop metrics for measuring use of new digital resources as developed and measure use in 2020, and develop a plan to increase use by 10% to be implemented in 2021.
- Increase AgGateway membership by 30 new members (globally), establish metrics for member engagement, and measure member engagement for 2020 by December 31, 2020.
- Develop multi-year marketing and communication plan focused on communicating AgGateway successes and the value of membership through appropriate media by 31 January 2020 and implement throughout 2020.


Committees

- Purpose To provide unique identifiers for the facilitation of eAgriculture interactions
